

MacFarlane Park – After School Clubs

Club Session Begins: Tuesday—September 7th, 2010

Club Session Ends: Friday—October 28th, 2010

*Normal Club Sessions run for 9 weeks. Club Sessions begin on September 7th with the first Monday Club beginning on September 13th. (There are no Wednesday Clubs due to Early Release Days) Each club is \$10/week + any supplies fee. Club fees must be paid in full prior to the start of the club. Students will not be allowed to participate until club fees are paid. All fees are paid directly to the Teacher / Coach. **Don't wait as these clubs fill up quickly!***

MONDAY

Clay Club with Ms. Klepal: 4th-5th Grade (12 students max) this unique clay club will give students the ability to learn various techniques in working with clay including pinch pots, coil building and slab building. Students will also learn about where clay comes from and how it changes when fired. Art room—Fee: \$70 (\$10/week)* + \$15 supplies fee

M.I.T: Electronic Portfolios: 2nd-5th Grade (10 students max) —Lights, camera, portfolio action! Ms. Addington will help students create electronic portfolios to showcase their academic and social experiences throughout the school year. This portfolio will provide a basic framework for the entire school year. Students will learn how to take digital photos, capture video, and scan documents. These keepsakes will be incorporated into your child's electronic portfolio. Students will continue to add work to their portfolio throughout the school year! Students will keep activities from the classroom and "special area" on their USB ports. This will not only serve as a "digital academic scrapbook" for your child, but a valuable technological learning experience. Classroom—Fee: \$70 (\$10/week)* + student provided USB port

Newspaper Club: 4th-5th (12 students max)—Hear Ye, Hear Ye!! Calling all 4th-5th Graders! Enjoy researching, investigating, and writing a newspaper? Then Mrs. Hoehn-Parish/Ms. Fonda's club is for you. Students will learn what it takes to make a great newspaper and work together to build their own newspaper from the ground up. Students will choose jobs, features, and other components of their newspaper they want to include and do. This student newspaper will be published monthly. Hoehn-Parish Classroom—Fee: \$70 (\$10/week)* + \$10 supplies fee

Robotics/non competitive: 2nd- 5th Grade (30 students max)—Under the direction of Mr./Mrs. Shaw the participation in the Robotics Club will offer your child an opportunity to learn teamwork, engineering skills, programming, problem solving, critical thinking skills and most of all- having fun while learning STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) concepts! Club members will use Lego Wedo and Mindstorms and other robotics tools to build robots and machines, program them to perform specific tasks, troubleshoot problems, and refine their strategies. Cafeteria—Fee: \$70 (\$10/week)* New members' \$40 supplies/consumables fee / returning members yearly \$10 supplies/consumables fee

MONDAY CONTINUED:

S.H.E.(Strong, Healthy, Energetic):3rd-5th Grade girls / Ms. Vinson (12 students max)—Girls will train for and run a 5K race. Training will include both strength and endurance work. The goal of this program is to help girls become physically determined, emotionally strong and supported young women thought the camaraderie of other girls and runners who are empowered by their physical strength, mental determination and tenacity of purpose. Race Day will be on a weekend, so a Saturday or Sunday is expected. Covered Court—Fee: \$70 (\$10/week) *

Smart Board Club: 3rd-5th Grade (10 Students max) Ms. Nanfra—Come have fun with Smart board Technologies. Learn how to create interactive activities using different Smart Board tools. Tuesday Boy's Running Club with Leslee Brackin: 2nd-5thGrade Weekly instruction includes: form and technique, benefits of aerobic movement, staying uninjured, nutrition, and the importance of recovery. Strengthening and flexibility exercises plus fitness walking and/ or running will be led by Mrs. Brackin. 2nd session will end in participation of 5k race, as a group.
